Using envelopes regularly tells our children that giving to the Church is a priority for us. Offertory in envelopes makes the ongoing budgeting process easier for the Parish and becomes a "budget" item for us. The envelope number identifies our contributions for tax receipt purposes. It makes it easier for staff to record our giving into the parish database. Let us treat our weekly gift to God with the care and respect we would with any other gift we give, and wrap it with our name and number on it.
